What is E2E?

E2E stands for Entry to Employment. It's an exciting learning programme for 16-18 year olds, funded by the Learning and Skills Council.

If you aren't quite ready for an apprenticeship or a job, E2E can help you build your skills, motivation and confidence. The aim is to help you prepare for an apprenticeship, work or further education.

What makes it different?

E2E is really flexible. There's no time limit, and the work-based learning programmes are developed around your needs, to gain the qualifications, you need to progress.

You'll:

- have the support of a Key Worker from start to finish
- develop a good understanding of the types of work available and what you need to get a job, get into college or onto an apprenticeship
- discover how to develop the career that's right for you
- develop valuable new skills to get a job, get into college or onto an apprenticeship
- get support with literacy and numeracy if you need it
- our experienced Key Workers are there for you to help you achieve
- have the opportunity to gain one or more qualifications. How many you achieve is up to you!

What will I do on E2E?

You'll take part in challenging and exciting individual and group learning activities. These might include training centre activities, practical projects, sports activities, community activities, outward bound activities or residential events, skills training, job tasters and work-placements.

What qualifications could I get?

Where appropriate you'll be encouraged to work towards one or more qualifications while you're on E2E. This might include an NVQ (or units towards one), Basic and Key Skill awards, first aid or food hygiene certificates, youth achievement awards, or any other qualifications which are right for you and can be completed during your time on E2E.

Nova specialises in NVQ's in Motor Vehicle, Business and Customer Services and can also source or progress you to training for most trades.

How long will E2E last?

Your programme will be designed to meet your needs. It might last weeks, months, or a year or more. You'll be told at the start how long it's likely to take.

How many hours a week will it take?

Usually between 16 and 30 hours a week. Many people find they start off at the lower end, and increase over time.

Can I get help with travel fares and/or child care? And will I get paid?

Yes. Every young person who starts E2E will earn £30.00 per week plus bonus payments for attending and working hard. Travel expenses will be met, and assistance with childcare is available.
