CAN I APPLY FOR AN APPRENTICESHIP?

Yes - if you're 16-24 when you start your Apprenticeship, are not in full-time education, and live in England.

HOW?

You can apply for an Apprenticeship at any one of Nova Training's branches across the Black Country and Telford and Wrekin, at which point an initial interview and assessment will be arranged.

To participate in an apprenticeship you will need a placement with an employer who is prepared to pay you a minimum of £80 per week. If you can't find an employer Nova can help with support and guidance to do this. We have a bank of employers who take young people for apprenticeships so in most circumstances we can provide you with the placement you need.

Nova also employs Placement Officers who work across all of our centres so we are always finding new garages for learners.

ARE THERE DIFFERENT TYPES OF MOTOR VEHICLE APPRENTICESHIPS?

Yes - the right one for you will depend on your experience and your work placement. Nova delivers Motor Vehicle Apprenticeships in Vehicle Fitting and Maintenance and Repair. All of our Apprenticeships include:

An NVQ (National Vocational Qualification) at Level 2 or 3
Key skills qualifications in Communication, Application of Number and ICT

A Technical Certificate and other qualifications or requirements relevant to the job.

Apprenticeships can also be a stepping stone to university.

HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE?

There's no set time. A year or two is typical, but it depends on your ability and the employer's requirements.

HOW DO APPRENTICESHIPS WORK?

Your employer pays your wages and provides on-the-job training to achieve your NVQ. You'll spend one day per week in one of our training centres where you will learn the theory side of the trade and also have the opportunity to improve your practical skills in our Motor Vehicle workshops. You will gain a variety of skills that'll be useful in the job market, and you'll study for a technical certificate, which will give you further knowledge and understanding of your job.

HOW MUCH DO I GET PAID?

You will start off earning a minimum of £80 per week. As your skills develop your Assessor will talk to your employer at different stages of your programme with regards to paying you more.

WHAT SORT OF PERSON IS ACCEPTED ON TO A NOVA APPRENTICESHIP?

You need to be:

Serious and committed - show you've researched and understand the work, and that you're the right person for the job

Aware of your responsibilities to yourself and your employer

Prepared for further study

Realistic about the amount of work you may have to do

Happy to work as part of a team and as an individual

Able to use your own initiative
